Dear Parents and Guardians,

To foster students' interest in music, the school has implemented the "One Student, One Instrument" program. This initiative aims to enhance students' enthusiasm for music by offering after-school classes for Western musical instruments. Starting on October 27, 2026 (Tuesday), instrumental music training courses will begin to enhance students' sensory awareness, imagination, and curiosity in music education. These courses will provide students with a comprehensive and introspective approach to learning an instrument. Students who seek to improve their technical skills and musicianship will be encouraged to participate in performances during school celebrations, religious events, musical activities, and concerts. Each lesson costs HKD 50, with 20 lessons available for the entire year. The school subsidizes the remaining tuition fees for participants, including extra practice sessions where applicable. Refunds will not be issued unless approved upon proof of medical conditions or conflicting duties.

Venue: Pop Band Room (for Pop Band)

Form 3 Classroom (for Folk and Acoustic Guitar Class)

Class size: A maximum of 12 participants will be accepted per instrumental class, excluding the school choir, orchestra, and ensemble. Students who have achieved certain technical levels on their respective instruments or participated

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in relevant courses last year with satisfactory attendance will be given priority for ongoing professional development.

Please encourage your child to enrol in one of the courses mentioned above, where they can enjoy the experience of learning music through collective and holistic sound production. Please respond to this notice by 18 September 2026 (Friday). Late responses will not be accepted. If the number of participants exceeds the available vacancies, the department will make the final decision. Shortlisted applicants will receive an e-notice confirming their successful enrolment. If applicants are not shortlisted, a refund will be processed accordingly. For any further inquiries, please contact Dr. Ling Ka Chun at 2777 5117.

Participants should prepare their instruments in advance. Instrument rental services are limited and not guaranteed.
